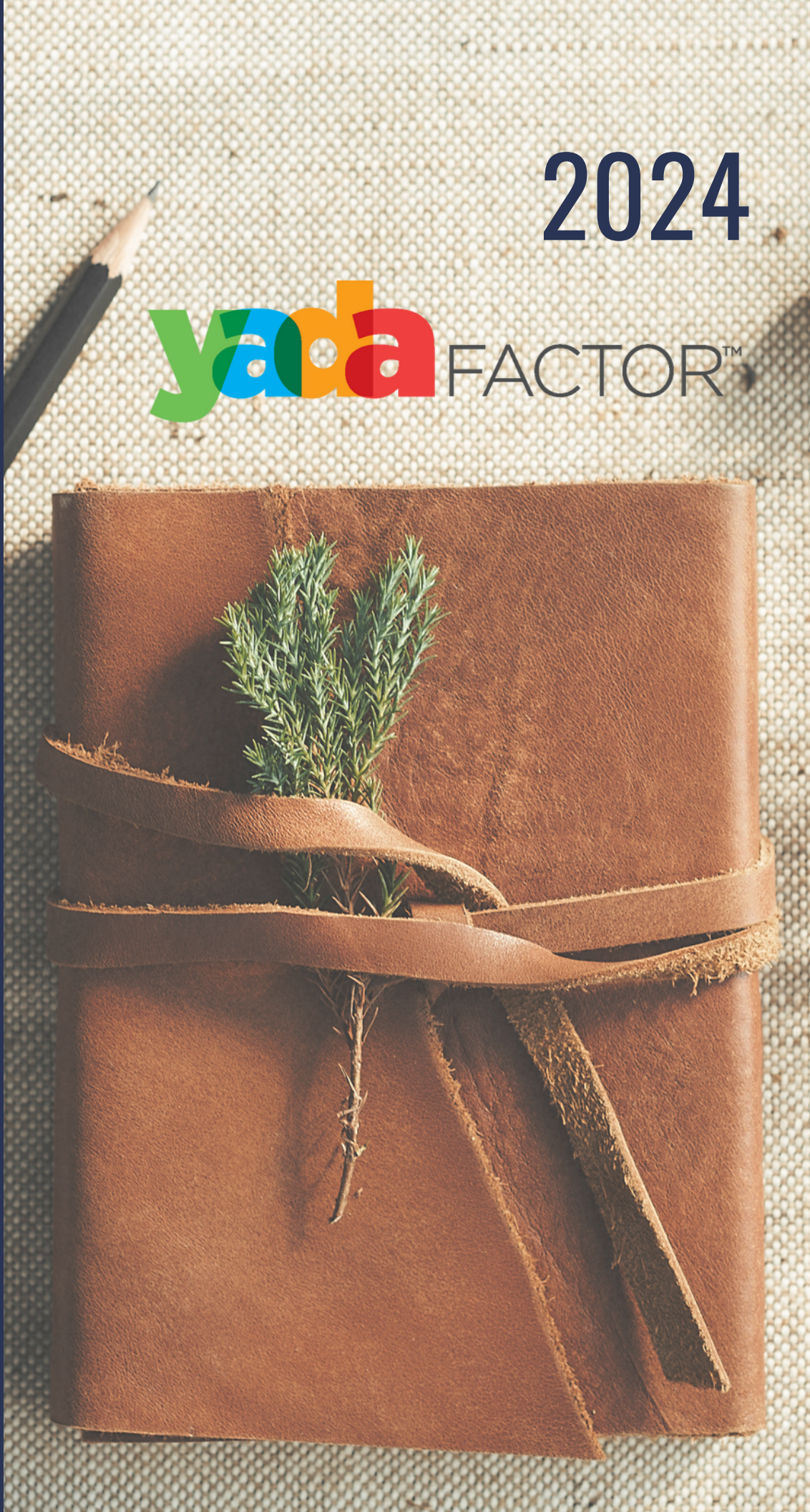

His Word in the past year.

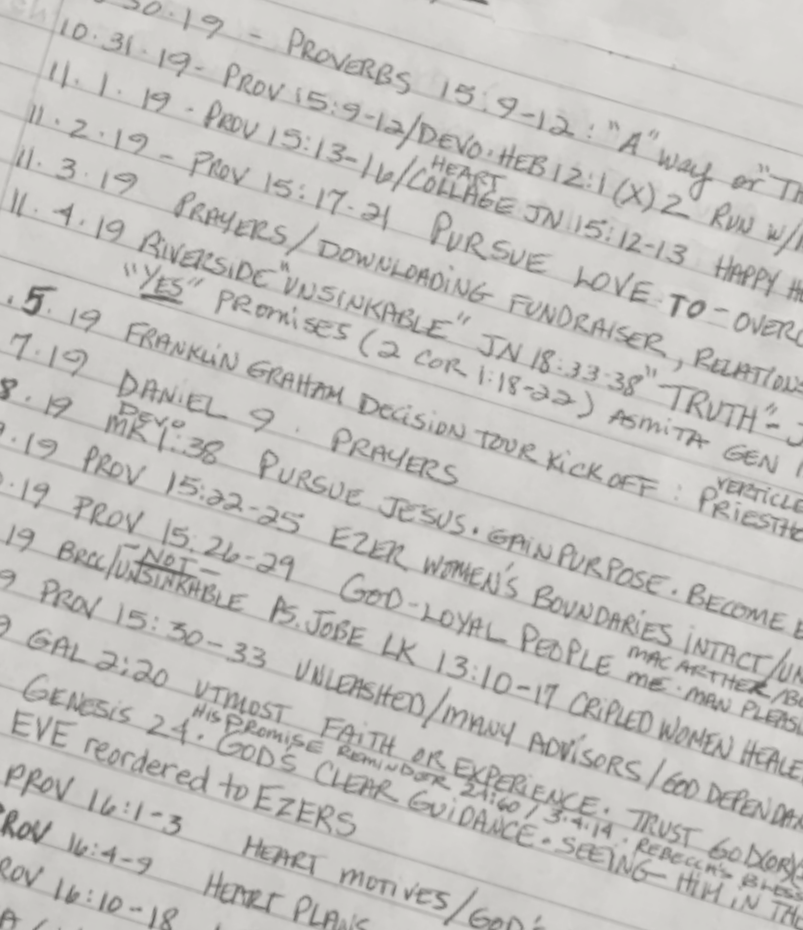
## WE REFER TO THIS AS A YEAR- END INVENTORY.
